Daily Feeding Guide

For horses and ponies in medium work: .5lbs of Maestro per 100lbs of bodyweight.

For horses and ponies in hard work: .5lbs to .8lbs of Maestro per 100 lbs of bodyweight.

Always provide fresh, clean water.

Combine with forage/fiber totaling 1.5%-2% of horses bodyweight daily.

Feeding rates above are a guide only.
