FEEDING DIRECTIONS:

- O Feed ½ to 1½ lb. per 100 lb. body weight and allow free choice pasture or hay.
- O Feeding levels may vary with the seasons, type of forage and the general condition of the horse. In general, an average size riding horse (1000 to 1200 lb.) should consume 5 to 10 pounds of LONGEVITY per day.
- O The amount given at any one time should be no more than 0.5% of the horse's body weight. For example, a 1000 lb. horse should be fed no more than 5 lb. per feeding.
- O Always provide clean, fresh water and salt.
- O Do not feed additional proteins, vitamins or minerals except on the advice of a nutritionist.
- O In many cases, even horses over 20 years of age can be kept in good condition with **ORIGINAL**® 12. Please consult McCauley's nutritionists for more information.
- O For horses experiencing difficulty in chewing hay and/or pasture, ALAM® may partially or completely replace the roughage portion of the diet.
- O Both ALAM and LONGEVITY can be fed as a mash.
- O Consult your veterinarian concerning proper health programs.
- O Always maintain good dental care and worm control program.
