Use the feeding table as a guide for feeding SafeChoice[®] Senior Horse Feed. Be sure to monitor your horse's body condition closely and adjust the feeding rate as necessary for the desired body condition and activity level.

If your horse has no dental problems, feed clean, good quality hay at the rate of 1.0 to 1.75 lb (kg) of hay per 100 lb (kg) of bodyweight per day or the pasture equivalent.

For horses who cannot consume roughage properly, feed SafeChoice[®] Senior at a rate of 1.2 - 1.6% of bodyweight per day, in replacement of roughage.

If your horse has severe dental problems, SafeChoice[®] Senior horse feed may be soaked with warm water to form QuickMash in just 3 minutes, or until it reaches the consistency your horse prefers. (Ideal soaking temperature is 101 F. Cooler temperature may require a longer soaking time)

Divide the recommended feeding level into two or more equally spaced feedings per day.

CAUTION: Store feed in a clean, cool and dry location. Storage area should be free of insects and rodents. Do not allow animals access to feedstuffs that show signs of insect or rodent infestation. Do not allow animals access to hot or moldy feedstuffs at any time.
